

Guidelines for the Transformative Blog, published by the Research Center for the History of Transformations (RECET)

Thank you for agreeing to write a contribution for the Transformative Blog.

We aim for the blog to become a prominent public forum for the discussion of various topics related to the history of transformations, including ones that engage with contemporary political issues.

Before you send your contribution, could you please ensure that it conforms to the following guidelines:

1. The length of the blog should be no more than 1,200 words.
2. The blog is to be written in a style that is accessible to a broad readership, and not just academic colleagues.
3. References are to be included in the text as hyperlinks or, if these are not possible, as endnotes.
4. The author's biography of no more than 50 words (separate to the word count for the blog itself) is to be added at the bottom of the blog.
5. Upon submission, the blog will be edited by the RECET team for language and style, upon which it will be returned to the author for a final confirmation. The final version of the blog should then be submitted within 3 days of the edits being sent to the author.
